

Typical Pole and Netting Installation Directions Please call for information pertaining to your specific needs.

Pole Installation Procedure:

- 1: Install the poles typically 10% height + 3 feet = depth of hole
- 2: Install the hardware
  - a. Eyebolts are for end cable attachments (see drawing)
  - b. Through bolts with suspension clamps are for mid span cable attachment (see drawing)
- 3: Hang the cable system
  - a. 5/16" plow cable is installed at each eyebolt with a twisted guy grip
  - b. Cable is then run through the suspension clamps until you end at another eyebolt.
  - c. Install guy anchors at each end of fence line (6 ea.)
  - d. 5/16" plow cable and guy grips are used to hang cable from top of fence to ground anchor.
  - e. Use <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" cable and cable clamps for mid-span guying (top of one pole to bottom of next pole)

## 4: Hang the netting

- a. Attach the netting to the cable system via hog rings, carabineer clips or lacing twine
- 5: Hang the wind line system.
  - a. For every 5/16" middle cable run a corresponding ¼" cable on the opposite side of the netting.
- 6: Hang the rope vertical wind line system:
  - a. On every wood pole run a rope over the netting and secure it to the wood pole via wood staples.
